Chinese Writing Courses

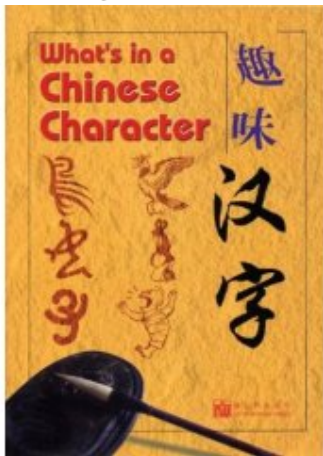
Chinese writing for Beginners

Duration: 60 Hours

Objectives & Requirement:: It is designed for students who are eager to learn written Chinese with basic Chinese knowledge. Students will be exposed to a wide range of characters based on approximately 600 vocabulary items with related patterns and expressions.

Expectations: After the 60 hours introduction lesson, student are expected to recognize 10 types of Chinese radicals, 300 Chinese characters, be able to read short stories and write simple sentences.

Teaching Material:



What's in a Chinese character, two-to-a-page style that introduces over 360 characters in cartoons, pinyin, common words using the characters and explanatory text. Good for students to help remember the images in basic, high-frequency characters, or for anyone seeking an introduction to written Chinese.
